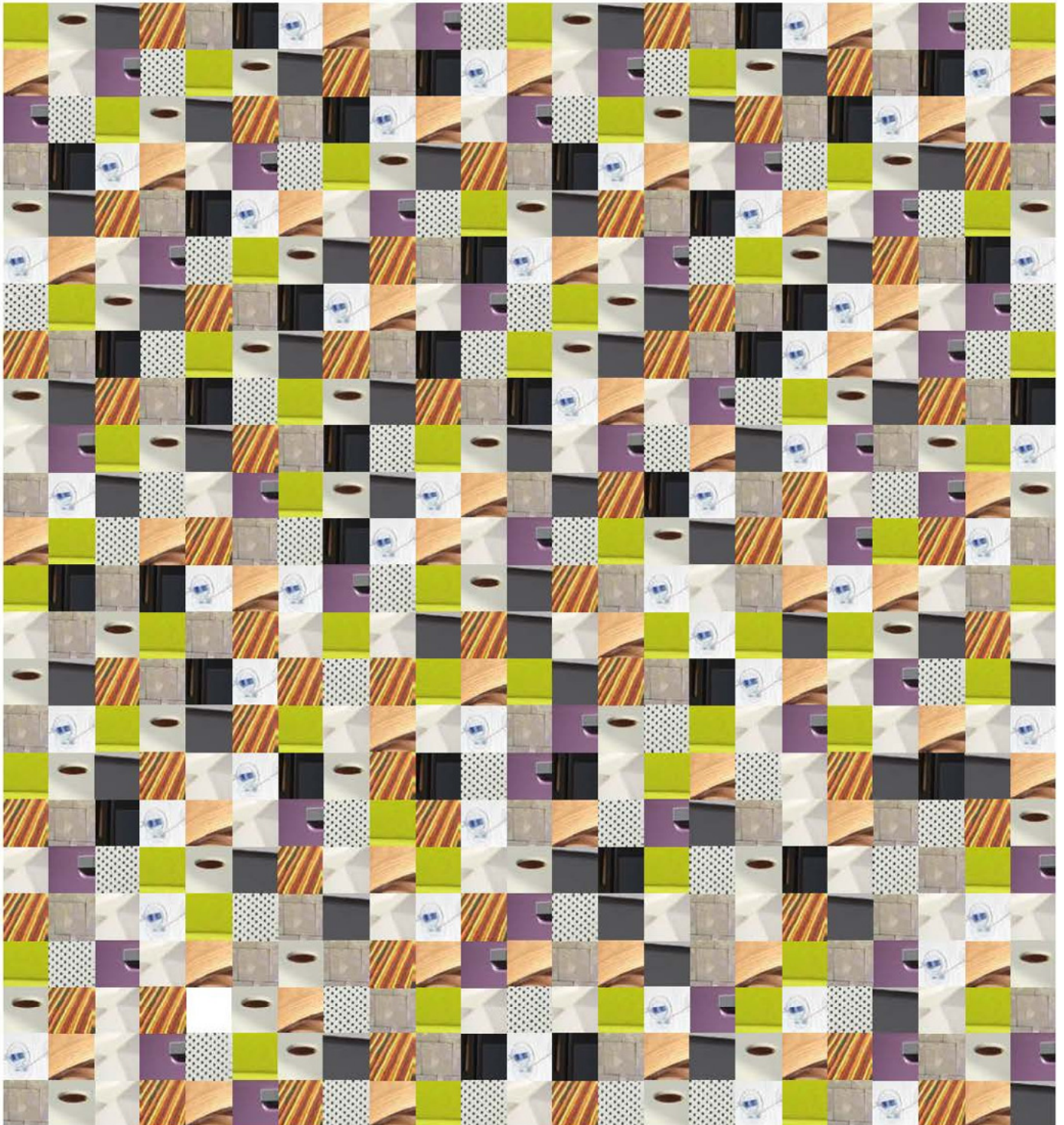

The Knelt posture kneeling stool and desk was created by Tim Spencer, a paediatric nurse, and was originally designed for children from 3-10 years old, but also successfully expanded to Knelt Adult. It provides a range of uses from writing, drawing and reading, to using laptops and watching TV. Knelt realigns your posture, reducing muscle and joint fatigue, resulting in increased concentration, productivity and enjoyment. British manufactured and hand finished in veneered moulded ply, it is available in birch, oak and American walnut.
